Keukenhof Gardens Day Trip plus Amsterdam City Tour / Duration: 07 Hours 30 Mins

For the complete Amsterdam experience, combine a city sightseeing tour with a trip to the Keukenhof Gardens. On a 2.5-hour morning coach tour, drive along idyllic canals, visit a classic Dutch windmill and view top Amsterdam attractions including the Royal Palace, National Monument and Albert Cuyp Market. Then spend your afternoon among the beautiful tulip fields of the Dutch countryside and witness the spectacular floral display of the world-famous Keukenhof Gardens on a guided walking tour, followed by free time to explore at your leisure.



AMSTERDAM CITY SIGHTSEEING TOUR (MORNING)

Begin your day with a sightseeing tour of Amsterdam. Perfect for first-time visitors, this 2.5-hour narrated tour by luxury coach shows you all of Amsterdam's highlights. View the Royal Palace, the National Monument, the Skinny Bridge and drive along the UNESCO World Heritage-listed canals lined with picturesque gabled houses. You'll also visit a classic Dutch windmill



along the Amstel River and stop at a diamond factory to see how gems are polished using traditional methods. Enjoy an two an half hours time to explore and have lunch before your afternoon tour (own expense).



KEUKENHOF GARDENS TOUR (AFTERNOON)

Board the coach in central Amsterdam and relax on the 45 minutes drive through the blooming fields of the Dutch countryside - an unforgettable sight in the spring. Continue to the star attraction and highlight of your day, the Keukenhof Gardens. With your provided admission ticket in hand, enter the gardens and follow your guide on a walking tour to learn about the history of this world-famous attraction.

The Keukenhof Gardens' springtime display of flowers is a feast for the eyes. Listen to gurgling streams, contemplate placid ponds, and soak up the blaze of color as you wander winding paths lined with millions of blossoming tulips, narcissis, daffodils, hyacinths and bluebells.

After the guided portion of your tour, you're free to explore at your leisure. Visit a special exhibit in one of the pavilions, or grab refreshments at a café stand (own expense). You'll have 3 hours at the gardens before re-boarding the coach and returning to Amsterdam in the evening.



DAY ACTIVITY: GUIDED VISIT OF THE PALACE OF VERSAILLES

Afternoon / Duration: 04:00Hrs / Dep. Time: 1400Hrs / Dep. Point: City Vision (Ground level from the hotel)



The Palace of Versailles was the residence of French Kings Louis XIV, Louis XV, and Louis XVI and their courts from 1682 until the French Revolution in 1789. With commentary from your guide played through individual headsets, discover the splendor of the Palace of Versailles, a symbol of royal power. Its sumptuous decoration, Baroque architecture, many works of art, and furniture were all created by the greatest craftsmen of the day. Then enjoy the beauty of the French gardens of Versailles at your own pace.

Set off for the Palace of Versailles from our agency in Central Paris at 2 p.m. Take advantage of the 45-minute journey by luxury air-conditioned coach to listen to your guide's introduction to the palace's history.

Stretching for more than 721,000 square feet, the Palace of Versailles has over 700 rooms. Follow your guide straight to the front of the line to tour the palace's most beautiful rooms: the King's Grand Apartments, with seven rooms each dedicated to a different god (Apollo, Mars, Mercy, Venus, etc.), and the Queen's Grand Apartments, mirroring those of the king, including the Coronation Room and the Queen's Bedroom, once occupied by Marie Antoinette. Also, marvel at the majestic "Hall of Mirrors" Versailles, a large reception room in which to see and be seen, dreamt up by the famous architect, Jules Hardouin-Mansart. Almost 240 feet-long, it was created to astonish visitors to the Sun King, Louis XIV; it is lit by 17 windows and some 350 mirrors, and overlooks the palace's breath-taking gardens, the second part of your visit.

In 1661, Louis XIV commissioned the landscape architect André Le Nôtre to lay out the gardens and grounds, something that was just as important to the king as the construction of the palace. Spend time exploring the Gardens of Versailles and admire the 386 works of art (including more than 200 statues), fountains, ponds, flower beds, and woodland. During the Summer months, a range of activities are organized, for example, the Grandes Eaux Musicales, when the garden's fountains "dance" in time to music.

- Important: Closing of the Queen's State Apartment for renovation works
- High-heeled shoes are not recommended due to parquet flooring in the rooms and cobblestones outside
- Strollers may not be taken into the palace
- Access to the palace can be challenging for visitors with reduced mobility
- Photography without flash is permitted inside the palace
- Tuesday mornings are not recommended because the palace is particularly busy
- The skip-the-line access is subject to the Versailles Palace procedures: The Vigipirate plan, the security control or an unforeseen crowd can slow down the entrance.



DAY 5 PARIS

DAY ACTIVITY: VISIT TO LOUVRE MUSEUM + EIFFEL TOWER + CRUISE + ILLUMINATION TOUR

Guided Visit of the Louvre Museum Walking Tour / Duration: 02 Hours 30Mins / Dep. Time: 09:30Hrs / Dep. Point: City Vision (Ground level from the hotel)





Your **priority access ticket** will allow you to follow your guide straight into the world's largest museum. No need to stand in line! This guided tour offers the perfect opportunity to learn about the museum's huge collection and its greatest works of art, such as the Mona Lisa, the Venus de Milo, and the Coronation of Napoleon.

Before it became a museum in 1793, the Louvre had long been one of the principle palaces of the Kings of France. Located right in the heart of Paris, the Louvre's galleries stretch for 786,000 square feet. It is home to the world's largest collection of art works, spanning more than 7,000 years from ancient civilizations to the 19th Century. The museum's collections are split into eight different departments: Egyptian antiquities, Greek, Etruscan & Roman antiquities, Near Eastern antiquities, Islamic art, Paintings, Sculptures, Decorative Arts, and Prints & Drawings.

Spend time discovering these collections with your guide, who will show you some of the museum's most famous works and tell you about the stories that lie behind them. Marvel at the Mona Lisa, painted by Leonardo da Vinci in 1506, one of the most famous female portraits in the world; the Venus de Milo, a celebrated Greek sculpture dating from 100 BC depicting the goddess Aphrodite; or the giant 33-foot-long painting of the Coronation of Napoleon, painted in 1807 by Jacques-Louis David to commemorate the crowning of Napoleon Bonaparte in Notre Dame Cathedral.

After your guided tour, spend time exploring other parts of the museum at your own pace.

PLEASE NOTE:

- After your tour, why not take advantage of your ticket and stay longer in the museum to eat or enjoy shopping for souvenirs such as posters, books, etc.
- The Louvre Museum closes at 6 p.m., or at 10 p.m. on Wednesday and Friday
- Large bags, strollers and umbrellas must be left in the museum cloakroom
- **This is a walking tour and is not suitable for those with reduced mobility**
- Elevators are not available during the tour
- The skip-the-line access is subject to the Louvre museum procedures: The Vigipirate plan, the security control or an unforeseen crowd can slow down the entrance.

Discover Paris's most famous sights and monuments on a single tour. This tour of Paris by night includes a visit to the second floor of the Eiffel Tower with breathtaking views of the illuminated capital, a panoramic coach tour of the city, plus an hour-long cruise along the Seine in a glass-topped boat. This comprehensive tour is the ideal way to experience the magic of Paris as nights falls.

Your tour by air-conditioned panoramic coach will give you an opportunity to visit Paris and learn about its history and most famous sights with an audio guide (individual headsets). Special commentary for children is also available in French, English, Spanish, Italian and German. Marvel at Paris's most beautiful and well-known sights: the Opera House, Place Vendôme Square, the Pantheon, the Orsay Museum, Place de la Concorde Square, the Luxembourg Palace and Gardens, the Champs-Élysées, the Arc de Triomphe and the Invalides.

Then step aboard for an hour-long audio guide cruise along the Seine on a glass-topped boat with terrace. Admire the stunning architecture of the heart of Paris's most prestigious monuments lining the banks of the Seine: The Louvre, Notre Dame de Paris Cathedral, the Conciergerie, the Orsay Museum, etc.

Thanks to your priority access with our Eiffel Tower tickets, you will skip the line and speed up to the second floor of the Eiffel Tower, Paris's most iconic monument. Built by Gustave Eiffel for the Universal Exhibition in 1889, it is 1,063 feet high. Take in the magnificent panoramic views



of the capital by night and spend time exploring this incredible monument on your own. Your tour will end at the Eiffel Tower.

PLEASE NOTE:

- The sequence of the tour is subject to change (i.e. visiting the Eiffel Tower before the Seine cruise). When the tour ends with the Seine river cruise, you have the possibility to do it later (Port de la Bourdonnais, Bateaux Parisiens company, in front of the Eiffel Tower. Departure every hour until 9.30pm). In that case, you need to inform the hostess about it.
- You are able to purchase the top floor ticket directly to the cash desk on the 2nd floor.
- The Seine river cruise ticket is given inside the coach upon the departure of the tour.
- In mid-Summer, part of the tour will take place in daylight
- The tour is not a guided one: the hostess does not give any commentary on the monuments.
- The skip-the-line access is subject to the Eiffel tower procedures: The Vigipirate plan, the security control or an unforeseen crowd can slow down the entrance.

DAY ACTIVITY: FULL DAY TOUR TO MONACO, MONTE-CARLO AND EZE

Enjoy a visit to Eze village and its perfume factory, then travel on to Monaco where you will see some of the most famous sights including the Cathedral and the Monte Carlo Formula One circuit.



This full day tour will introduce you to the natural beauty of the 'Moyenne Corniche' as we travel to Monaco with stops to appreciate the views and admire places of interest along the way. We make a stop at the medieval village of Eze, perched high on a cliff above the Mediterranean Sea. Whilst there you will have the chance to visit a traditional perfume factory. After a wander around the village where every street is full of charm and history, our tour then takes us on to Monaco where you will have free time to see the Cathedral where Princess Grace is buried, the changing of the guard at noon and the Palace, then we take a drive along the Formula One race circuit. Of course no Monaco tour would be complete without a stroll around Monte-Carlo with its Casino, superb hotels and beautiful gardens. The journey back to Nice will be via the 'Basse Corniche' for more superb views.

Transportation by minibus, hotel pick up and drop off, commentary by a driver-guide, guided visit of a perfume factory in Eze.
